## **PREPARING THE SUBMISSION**

Workshop proposals should be 2 page in length including references. Proposals should contain:

- Title
- Proposed duration
- Theme
- Goals
- Background
- Motivation
- Description of activities planned
- Required facilities
- Intended audience
- Short bio of the organizers

## **EVALUATION PROCESS**

All proposals will be reviewed by the workshop chairs. The decision on acceptance or rejection will be made on the basis of the overall quality of the proposal.
